NOTES TO THE TEACHER

This book contains answers to the exercises in the *The Rosetta Stone® English II Workbook*, which is designed to be used with the *English II* computer program.

The Rosetta Stone program focuses on four areas of language learning:

- Listening comprehension
- Reading comprehension
- Speaking
- Writing

In the computer program, students can use the matching exercises to improve their listening and reading comprehension, the voice-record feature to improve their pronunciation, and the dictation exercises to improve their writing skills. Students can then use the exercises in the *English II Workbook* to further develop the skills they have acquired.

The *English II Workbook* contains the following exercises:

- Units 9-16: one worksheet for every chapter except the review chapters; one Extra Practice section and one crossword puzzle at the end of each unit
- Units 18 and 19: two crossword puzzles for each unit

Because of the nature of the material, there are no exercises for Unit 17.

The Extra Practice sections present material that goes beyond the exercises in the computer program. Some of these sections are designed to improve students' understanding of grammar; others give students practice in writing letters and filling out forms.

Suggestions for use:

- As additional reading and writing practice in class or at home
- As additional listening and speaking practice in class
- As vocabulary review
- As daily quizzes
- As a quick check for comprehension of each chapter

Scoring:

- All worksheets and puzzles are based on a total of 100 points.
- Most worksheets have 20 items, for a possible value of 5 points each. Other worksheets have 15 items, the last five of which are worth 10 points each. The value of each story exercise is indicated in the answer key.
- The crossword puzzles contain 25 words, for a possible value of 4 points each.

The teacher is free to alter the weighting of the scoring.

The answers provided for the writing exercises parallel the text presented in *The Rosetta Stone* computer program. However, any appropriate response should be considered correct. No answers are provided for open-ended writing exercises.
